Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Greenfield Public Works Complex project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Greenfield, located at 599 El Camino Real, Greenfield, CA 93927.

The funding would be used to purchase and install a new modular Public Works operations facility to replace an existing building with documented fire, life-safety, and building code deficiencies, including serious electrical hazards, inadequate ventilation, and restroom facilities that do not meet California ADA standards.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it resolves documented occupational safety hazards that threaten city employees and the continuity of essential municipal services, including maintenance of roads, drainage, and wastewater systems that serve Greenfield's approximately 19,000 residents and a seasonal agricultural workforce that swells the population to over 30,000. At \$370,000 for a modular facility, this is a cost-effective capital investment for a small, disadvantaged rural community with limited resources to address these longstanding deficiencies independently.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S.C. § 1926(a), which supports the construction and improvement of essential community facilities in rural areas, including public works and municipal operations facilities. The City of Greenfield meets the program's rural eligibility criteria with a population under 20,000 located outside a metropolitan statistical area.
