What Must Be Included in My Nomination Application Packet?

A complete nomination packet consists of the following items:

- Our website's completed application form, listing the applicant's academy preferences in order of descending desirability
- High School Transcripts (can be unofficial)
- Community College Transcripts (if applicable)
- AP/IB scores (if applicable)
- SAT and/or ACT scores
- Current Resume
- An essay detailing the applicant's intent to attend the military service academies.
- Record of a recent physical performed by a medical professional (required for the service academies; can be the same physical used for the academy's application)
- Minimum of two letters of recommendation. LoRs cannot be from an immediate or extended family member. (LoRs from academic, athletic, or volunteer experience are preferred.)
- A catalogue of the sports and athletic activities the applicant has been involved in, and at
 what level of performance. Evidence of leadership in athleticism is highly favored, such
 as being the team captain of a sports team.
- Evidence of a completed application to the academy(s) that the applicant is applying for.
 Some academies won't consider an application complete until they receive a congressional nomination. For our purposes, evidence of a completed application can be a screenshot of every requirement satisfied, except the nomination from our Office.

To Note: All items must be received by our office's application deadline for full consideration.
